

Police charge man after May car crash

A Brampton man is facing charges in connection with a multi-vehicle collision on Maple Ave. at Guelph St. Thursday, May 27 that left a Georgetown woman seriously injured.

Halton Police announced the charges Tuesday, after an investigation.

Charged with failure to stop at the scene of an accident, dangerous operation of a motor vehicle causing bodily harm, and criminal negligence causing bodily harm is Austin Elson, 62.

Elson is to appear in Milton court July 28.

The 55-year-old woman injured in the crash has been released from hospital.

Police report about 4:30 p.m. May 27 a Dodge Caravan driven by the accused struck a vehicle in the intersection of Mountainview Rd. and Maple Ave. The driver did not stop, but continued southwest on Maple Ave.

Near the intersection of Guelph St. the van collided with an Acura driven by the 55-year-old woman. The impact caused a chain reaction resulting in three other vehicles being involved in the incident.

Police are investigating the theft of two Aquamarine inflatable boats from a dock in Fairy Lake at Breezes Trailer Park on Dublin Line in Acton. The boats are valued at \$1,500 each. One of the boats was taken sometime between June 13 and Sunday. The owner replaced the boat, and the new boat was stolen sometime between 9 p.m.

Sometime between midnight and 5:22 a.m. Sunday a 1999 Dodge Ram was stolen from a Mill St. W. residence in Acton. The truck, valued at \$5,000, was recovered later that day in a pond in Brant County.

Approximately \$4,300 worth of items, including a bag of jewelry, was taken from an unlocked vehicle parked on Main St. S. Thursday between 9:30 a.m. and 1 p.m.
