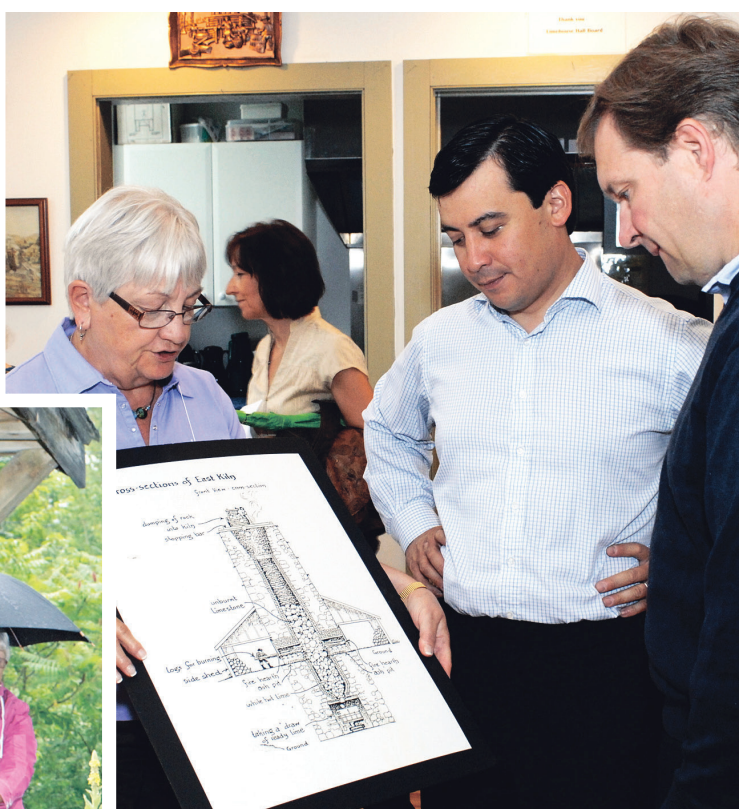


Kiln
