**Habitat for Humanity Halton's ReStore** hosted its fourth Annual Open House Sale on Saturday, June 19 at 1800 Appleby Line. Oakville's Kinsmen hosted a charity barbecue on site from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Tim Horton's coffee and fresh popcorn was served free from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. by **ReStore** staff and volunteers. **Habitat's ReStore** sells quality used and surplus building materials and household products at a fraction of retail prices. These materials are donated by contractors with excess supplies, from demolition crews salvaging reusable materials, and from the general public. For example, homeowners renovating kitchens can arrange for **ReStore** volunteers to remove their existing acceptable cabinets and appliances for free and receive a tax receipt for the value paid for the item. This helps the environment by diverting thousands of tons of usable materials away from landfills.

**Habitat for Humanity Halton** is a local, non-profit, faith-based organization working

for a world where everyone has a safe and decent place to live. Its mission is to leverage resources to create and promote safe and affordable home ownership options with the aim of alleviating the cycle of poverty within our community.


