# OAC seeks a Georgetown Rose

The Ontario Agricultural College (OAC) dairy school opened in 1893. The announcement for the first course invited ladies to attend and five of the first enrolment were female. This was the first time a course at the OAC was opened to women.

Professor H. H. Dean, then Head of the Dairying Department, commenting on the female students, said, "To the ladies who attended the course we are indebted for (the) courage shown (by them) in making a start towards breaking down the prejudices that exist against women in scientific dairying."

One female graduate from that first dairy course was Ms. Laura Rose. Upon completion she was appointed to the staff of instructors, making her the first female teacher at the OAC.

Rose was an immensely interesting person. She was born in 1866 in Georgetown, and attended secondary school in Guelph. She was from a family of five brothers and her father, Lawrence Rose, had a mill in Georgetown that gave rise to the 'Five Roses' brand of flour. In her late teens she left

her Georgetown home to 'keep house' for an older brother, Will Rose, on a North Dakota homesteading farm. As well as her farm duties she taught in the local rural school. These experiences made her recognize the need for better conditions in the farm home, a cause to which she was devoted to for many years.

During her 14 years as a faculty member in the Dairying Department Rose instructed a course in Dairy Butter and Cheesemaking and wrote a 300-page text, 'Farm Dairying', that went through four editions and served as a text in several agricultural schools. She was also active in organizing Women's Institutes in Ontario and other provinces, and wrote frequent articles on home and farm life for Canadian

and U. S. magazines. The University of Guelph is planning a celebration of her achievements and would like very much to contact any of Rose's (Mrs. Laura Rose Stephens) descendants living in this area.
