the extracurricular activities.

"New clothes and day trips are not happening," she said, adding her family remains hopeful.

The audit day was not just about poverty rates, said Colleen Sym, executive director of Halton Community Legal Service.

"There's a gap between social assistance and what's needed to survive," she said. "The day was about how Halton can do better."

The legal service organization led organizing of the social audit on behalf of the Interfaith Social Assistance Reform Coalition (ISARC).

The audit provides social assessment of government policy's impact on groups, and aims to find trends, themes and opportunities for intervention.

Poverty witnesses told stories of facing eviction, living in substandard accommodation, being ill and unable to work and facing a system that turned away from them, said Sym.

"We heard of a need for streamlining of administration," she said. "There was the complaint that they had to tell their story too often. We need to enhance services region-wide."

Milton Councillor Colin Best said social agencies often operate separately.

"There are a host of organizations and most people are not aware how to access them," said the Milton councillor. "There are conflicting goals and targets and they just hear part of the problem."

Rick Goldring noted the poverty issue has been going on forever.

"It seems to me we're not making real
