24. Circuit Class - 22" top of hitch to ground
25. No weights are to extend more than 26 inches beyond front foremost portion of truck.
26. Weights must be secure.
27. Any object that becomes detached from the truck during pull – the truck must stop immediately and will be disqualified.
28. All braking systems must be working.
29. All axles must be bolted on.
30. Conditions of driver & vehicle eligibility will be the decision of the track official.
31. Subject to track official - the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place vehicles in light class may be allowed to pull in heavier class.
