#### SECTIONS 1 - 18 ARE FOR EXHIBITORS 12 TO 14 YEARS OF AGE CRAFTS

1. Use recycled material to make a decorative candle holder. Use at least 2 different media (e.g. glass and paint).
2. Magnetic refrigerator magnet with a Ladybug theme
3. Hand-crafted Christmas ornament
4. Assemble a hobby craft from a kit, paint & decorate it
5. Decorate a clay pot with the Ladybug theme
6. Decorate a cloth tote bag
7. Create a titled sports team or sports personality presentation. Use a background of cardboard or bristol board no larger than 60cm by 90cm. Include a variety of media and ensure that all items securely attached.
8. Any other craft
