Eleven youth, between the ages of 16 and 20, will be travelling as members of the Canadian Youth Delegation to the United Nations Convention on Biological Diversity 10th Conference of the Parties in Nagoya, Japan in October. There, the youth will present the International Youth Accord on Biodiversity to the world leaders, which they created through collaboration with youth


