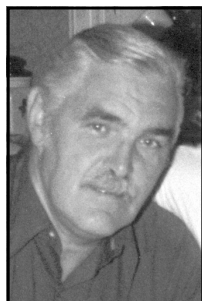
JEFFREY, Jo-Anne
