**Public gets first chance to share views on \$2B transportation plan**

A transportation master plan outlining how, when and where more than \$2 billion will be spent in Halton over the next 20 years will be the subject of public meetings over the next three months, the region's transportation planning authority announced Thursday.

The "Road to Change" master plan will be unveiled by a list of the necessary road expansion, bridge and infrastructure, the plan will be needed to accommodate the 300,000 more people that are expected to call the region home by 2021.

The Road to Change will build on the already existing transportation master plan developed in 2004, and updated in 2007. That plan has more than 200 projects to the year 2021 and is available online at www.halton.ca/transportation.

A public information centre to set for tomorrow (Thursday) at the Lakeshore Sports Centre, 1200 Lakeshore Drive, will be open from 10 a.m. to 7 p.m.

At the end of December 31, the Region had already set aside \$1.6 billion for road expansion. This year's budget included an additional \$100 million, and \$200 million more is included in the capital budget forecast for 2011-15. About \$100 million will likely be needed for the 2012-2015 time period, according to Region infrastructure.

While the vast majority of that money will be spent on roads, the Region intends to continue to increase the use of transit, including walking for Halton residents.
