

Rosser to speak at businesswomen's meeting

The Business and Professional Women's Club of Halton will focus on Women in the International Arena at its Wednesday, Sept. 22 meeting at the Glen Williams Town Hall.

Starting at 7:30 p.m., there will be a presentation from Emily Rosser titled: *Women's Activism as Survivors of Violence: The Struggle Towards Justice in Guatemala*.

From 1960-1996, a U.S.-supported counter-insurgency war decimated indigenous Maya populations in Guatemala. The United Nations declared it a genocide. They mandated a truth commission, which highlighted

the use of rape as a weapon of war, but the perpetrators were never punished. Many retain political power, and continue to support the exclusion and inequality of all women, and particularly of Mayan women.


Rosser, who has spent time in Mexico and Guatemala will discuss this historic event in the context of women's fight for justice for wartime sexual violence internationally and for all women's rights to be full citizens.

Rosser, who grew up in Georgetown, is a doctoral candidate in women's studies at York University, a Canada Graduate Scholar and a

research associate with the Centre for Research on Latin America and the Caribbean (CERLAC). She spent the summer conducting field research for her dissertation in Guatemala City.

NOTICE OF A PUBLIC OPEN HOUSE

SCHOOL SITES LAND USE PLANNING STUDY

The Town of Halton Hills will host a Public Open House regarding the School Sites Land Use Planning Study. The study will examine the following:

- The land use policy and regulatory approach that should be adopted by the Town for lands that are the site of existing schools within urban and rural areas and lands that have been identified by the school boards as being potentially necessary in the future; and
- The appropriate land use planning process to be adopted when the whole or part of a school site is to be declared surplus.

The Town of Halton Hills retained Meridian Planning Consultants Inc. to prepare the School Sites Land Use Planning Study which is being undertaken through a five phase planning process as follows:

- Phase 1: Background Analysis and Issue Identification
- Phase 2: School Site Policy and Regulatory Options
- Phase 3: Preferred Policy and Regulatory Alternative
- Phase 4: Initial Policy Formulation
- Phase 5: Final Policy and Regulatory Formulation

Meridian Planning Consultants have prepared a School Sites Background, Issues and Options Paper (the key deliverable for Phases 1 and 2), which provides pertinent information related to Provincial, Regional and Town policies and regulations, summarizes land use approaches used in other municipalities, discusses the relationship between school sites and parks and recreation, provides five possible land use options for further discussion, and outlines potential recommendations for legislation and policy changes by the Town, Region, Province and School Boards.

The format of the Public Open House will be a presentation at 7:00 pm followed by a question and answer session.

The purpose of the Public Open House is to:


- Increase public awareness of the School Sites Land Use Planning Study;
- Provide a summary of the School Sites Background, Issues and Options Paper; and
- Invite public input on the project.

All interested citizens are encouraged to attend the Public Open House, ask questions of Town staff and Meridian Planning Consultants Inc., and provide feedback on the School Sites Land Use Planning Study.
