Coffee Break is the Alzheimer Society's major nationwide annual fundraiser where friends, co-workers and customers gather in communities across Canada to raise funds for local Alzheimer Societies.

Participants at these events make a donation in exchange for a cup of coffee. The money raised stays in the province or community to help support local programs and services.

Every day there will be a draw for fresh-baked treats, coffees and accessories, and all participants will receive a special edition newsletter filled with recipes, puzzles, coffee lore and nutritional information.
