A lockdown at Christ the King Secondary School Tuesday morning was based on a false alarm say Halton Region-

On Tuesday, shortly after the lockdown was lifted, police reported that a 16-year-old male had been arrested after allegedly threatening a male student with what was believed to be a knife in the school.
