CAShh president Joanne Markus wants everyone to know that the organization is not making the calls and the only phone solicitation that is done on behalf of CAShh is for ticket sales for a benefit hockey game organized by Halton Woodcarvers (Jan. 9 at Mold-Masters SportsPlex) and in the summer for a benefit concert.

Markus said, to date, they have not heard that anyone has given money to the caller, and the phone number the call is originating from is blocked.

"We are so fortunate to have such great support from our community and hate the thought of anyone being misled and possibly being stolen from," said Markus.

Safe Start tally: 2,157 tickets

Halton Police handed out 2,157 tickets during Project Safe Start that began Sept. 1 and wrapped up last Friday.

Officers were focusing on the five S's-Speeding, Seatbelts, Stop signs, School zones and School buses- during the region-wide project designed to remind drivers of the need to be courteous to each other and children as they head back to school.

Across the region police handed out 1,883 speeding tickets, 128 for infractions at stop signs, 45 for not wearing a seatbelt and 101 for distracted driving (using a cell phone).

In Halton Hills and Milton there were

561 speeding tickets issued— 258 for 0 to 15 km over the limit, 293 for 16 to 29 km over, and 10 for 30 to 49 km over. Halton Hills and Milton had the highest number of tickets issued for stop sign infractions (59), for not wearing a seatbelt (32) and for distracted driving

There were 606 speeding tickets in Burlington, 38 stop sign infractions, one seatbelt ticket and 28 distracted driver tickets handed out.


In Oakville there were 716 speeding tickets, 31 stop sign infractions, 12 seatbelt tickets and 27 distracted driver tickets issued.
