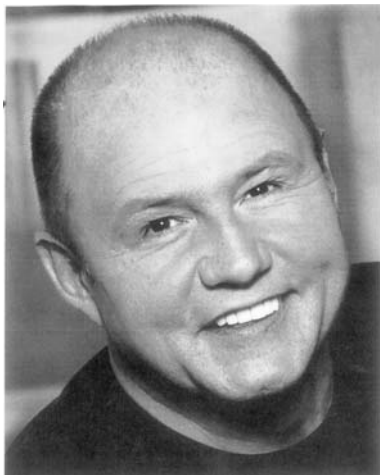
Tickets are \$35 and available at the Theatre's Box Office or online (haltonhills.ca/theatre) or by calling 905-877-3700.

This week, Bullard began hosting a new noon-hour show on Newstalk 1010 called *Beyond the Mike*.

Bullard is best known as the Gemini award-winning host of *Open Mike*, Canada's most successful late night talk show. The show ran on The Comedy Network, CTV and Global from 1997 to 2004.

Before getting his talk show he travelled far and wide on Canada's stand up comedy club circuit. More recently he worked as radio personality

on XM radio, TALK 820 and Newstalk 1010.

Bullard makes over 150 appearances a year for organizations such as The United Way, Big Brothers and Sisters, Foster Parents Plan, Casey House, The Humane Society and the Hospital for Sick Children, among others.
