Yard Waste

No Plastic

Plastic bags are not accepted in yard waste collection. Plastic does not decompose and reduces the quality of the final compost product.

Only use paper yard waste bags or open, reusable, rigid containers labelled "yard waste." Yard waste labels are available at no charge. To order a yard waste label, visit www.halton.ca/waste, or contact Halton Region.

Acceptable yard waste materials include yard and garden trimmings, pumpkins, fallen fruit from trees, and tree trimmings. Please "grasscycle" by leaving grass clippings on your lawn.
