Brownbag Reading Series

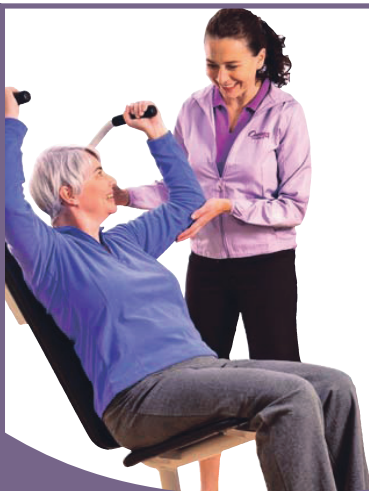
