



First, change the way you drive. Simply respecting the speed limit will help you save a lot of gas. Driving at 120 kph in a 100-kph zone represents an additional 10 to 20 % in gas consumption, depending on the car or truck. For city driving, try to avoid congested streets and, most of all, avoid accelerating at each traffic light as if you were drag racing. Many cities now synchronize their traffic lights. If you abide by the posted speed limit, you may encounter only green lights. This saves gas. On really warm days, air conditioning is very useful. However, if you can get fresh air by lowering the windows without suffering too much in traffic, you will save a few more drops of gas!

Of course, keeping your car or truck in top shape will help reduce your fuel consumption. Clean air filters are inexpensive, so change yours regularly. One of the most popular recommendations, yet still ignored, is to keep the air pressure in your tires at the suggested maximum. You have no idea how much you can save with correctly inflated tires! Finally, keep your car clean. This doesn't mean that you should wash it every day; it means that you should keep the trunk area free of useless junk that adds weight to the car. Added weight is one of your worst enemies.

The correct air pressure in your tires will help you save on fuel.
