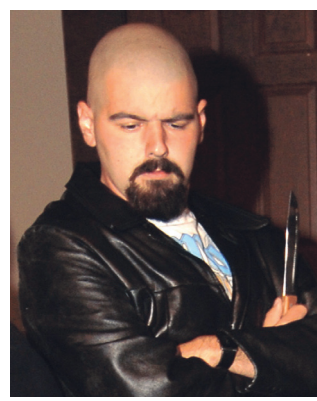
In a Greenwich Village apartment, a blind woman is stalked by gang members who believe she is in possession of a doll stuffed with heroin—a doll her husband brought back from Canada as a favour to a friend, without knowing what it contained. The gang members think this will be an easy job that will lead to untold riches, but nothing is ever as easy as it seems.

Georgetown Little Theatre Productions Inc. opens its 50th anniversary season with the production of *Wait Until Dark*, a nail-biting thriller by Frederick Knott and directed by Doug Feggans.

Knott's twisty drama opened on Broadway in 1966 and was followed by a film in 1967 starring Audrey Hepburn in an Oscar-nominated performance as the blind heroine.

Wait Until Dark is a rare theatrical

delight, working on themes and motifs usually reserved for suspense novels and movies. Everyone enjoys a good drama and a good scare and director Doug Feggans hopes that audiences leave the theatre thoroughly shaken from this terrifying roller-coaster of a thriller.

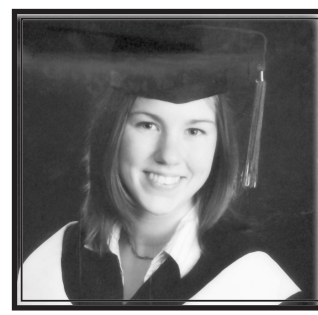


Terry Morton plays one of the threatening thugs in GLT's *Wait Until Dark*.
