## Food drive Saturday

Scouts and guides will be out collecting food from Georgetown area residents for Georgetown Bread Basket Saturday.

The Scout/Guide Annual Food Drive helps feed the 170 families, including 200 children, who use the food bank.

Items most needed are peanut butter, canned meats, stews, fish, soups, cheese spreads, canned juice and juice boxes, canned fruit and vegetables, pasta sauce, cereal, nutritious snacks for children including mini fruit cups, macaroni and cheese, instant coffee and personal grooming items.

Donated items should be left on the front step/porch by 8:30 a.m. in the paper bag that was provided in the Tuesday, Nov. 2 edition of *The Independent & Free Press*.

The youths will be collecting food in Georgetown, Glen Williams and Stewartstown.

Volunteers are needed to help drive the youths on some collection routes and help sort and pack boxes at Alliance Church to be taken to the Georgetown Bread Basket.

Volunteers are asked to show up at the church, 290 Main St., S., as of 10 a.m. Volunteers will be needed later in the day at the food bank, 55 Sinclair Ave., to help with the unloading of heavy boxes (up to 50 lbs).
