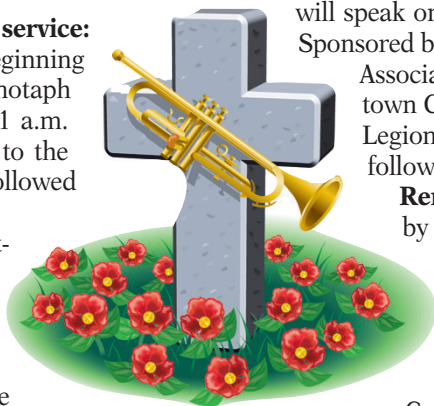

Amy Fennell who works at the Douglas G. Cockburn Centre for Birds of Prey, at Mountsberg Conservation Area will be the speaker. The Mountsberg facility, also known simply as "The Raptor Centre" provides a home to more than 30 native Ontario birds (approximately 14 different species) that can no longer survive in the wild due to permanent injury.



Most of these birds have been directly and negatively impacted by human activity, and they provide a unique opportunity to closely observe Ontario's native wildlife while at the same time illuminating some of the common issues faced by our native species when sharing their habitats with humans. 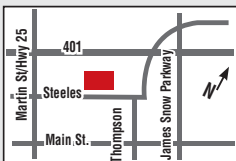
