Being a Big Brother or Sister can make a huge difference in the life of a child who needs a positive adult role model.

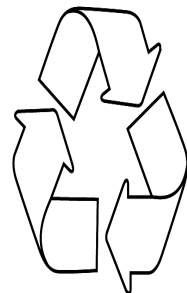


