**Free Community Dinner in Acton on Friday**

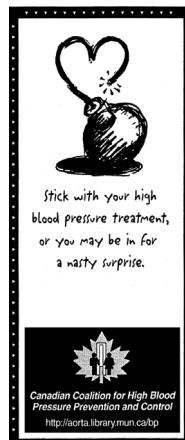

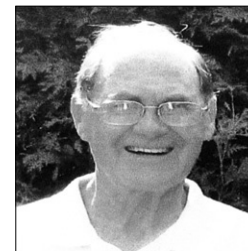

**COMMITTEES OF COUNCIL**

The Town of Caledon is currently seeking expressions of interest from community-minded residents who wish to serve on Committees for the 2011-2014 term of Council.

An Application must be submitted for each committee. For qualification(s) refer to the Term of Reference as qualifications vary. The Application Form and the Terms of Reference for each committee is available on the Town of Caledon website: [www.caledon.ca](http://www.caledon.ca) (under Committees) or at Town Hall.

Accessibility Advisory

Qualifications: A person with a disability and/or an interest in matters regarding person(s) with disabilities are encouraged to apply. The committee meets monthly in the evening.

Agricultural Advisory

Qualifications: Possess an agricultural interest and experience, including appointments from other recognized agricultural organizations. Skills in marketing and/or agricultural related tourism. The committee meets monthly in the evening.

Committee of Adjustment

Qualifications: Members should possess a legal, real estate and/or planning background and knowledge of the Planning Act. Knowledge and/or expertise in Committee of Adjustment process and/or previous experience on a committee, task force or tribunal would be an asset. There are 14 hearings a year and the committee meets Wednesday at 1:00 p.m. Remuneration \$127.12 per Hearing.

Economic Development Advisory

Qualifications: In accordance with the Caledon Economic Development Strategy 2008-2012, the Caledon Economic Development Advisory Committee (CEDAC) supports the achievement of the Town's goal of cultivating a diverse and prosperous economy per the recently approved Community Based Strategic Plan. The committee meets quarterly in the afternoon.
