Police blotter: Suspect caught on camera

Halton Police have released security photos of the suspect in the robbery at Shoppers Drug Mart on Guelph St. Saturday, Nov. 13.

Police say shortly after 11:15 p.m. a man entered the store and went to the pharmacy counter where he demanded OxyContin. He indicated he had a gun, but no gun was seen.

He was given an undisclosed quantity of drugs and left the store. No one was injured.

The suspect was last seen fleeing west-bound on Guelph St. riding an older model dark-coloured mountain bike.

The suspect is described as white, 6'3", 170 lbs., 40 to 50 years old, with a skinny build, sandy blonde hair mixed with grey and a raspy voice. He was wearing a dark toque, dark, thick long sleeve sweater, dark pants, beige construction style boots, dark gloves, an orange mesh construction vest with yellow reflective strips and light blue surgical mask covering the lower part of his face.


