**Town okays lease deal with museum**

Halton Hills council has approved a lease agreement with the Halton Hills Sports Museum.

The new five-year lease for the Gordon Alcott Heritage Hall, located within the Mold-Masters SportsPlex, includes some new conditions on the Town's rental of the facility. In order to protect the artifacts, many of which have been donated, HHSM has requested new guidelines for rental of the hall.

Events that pose minimum concern for damage will be allowed such as Town meetings, Town programs such as yoga or dance, receptions with no alcohol or tournament headquarters.

Events that include an alcohol permit will now require a \$1,000 security deposit and/or paid Town staff to be present the entire time.

Events such as family gatherings (including birthday parties), programs with high impact activities and martial arts will

no longer be permitted. These events in the past— particularly with a large number of unsupervised children— has resulted in damage to the hall and equipment.

There will be no rental charge, but HHSM must provide proof of insurance coverage of \$2 million. Any improvements to the hall for the museum is at the expense of HHSM with prior permission from the Town.

In a recent presentation to council, Finn Poulstrup, HHSM chair, said more than 2,000 people visited the museum in 2010, giving it rave reviews.

"There is no other community sports museum like this in Ontario," said Poulstrup.

The group has also contracted with local historian Mark Rowe to write a history of sport, scheduled for release in July.

The group also launched a new website, [www.hhsm.ca](http://www.hhsm.ca) and residents can now take a virtual tour of the museum.
