Special guest that evening will be saxophonist Charlie Finlay, who is one of the bright young jazz musicians on the Toronto scene. His band has appeared recently in New York, Chicago, Montreal and Toronto. He is also a composer, creating music for TV shows like the *Murdoch Mysteries*.

Expect to be entertained with a multi-media show of on-screen images and videos accompanying the Hammond organ, pipe organ, electric and acoustic piano, bass, drums and saxophone.

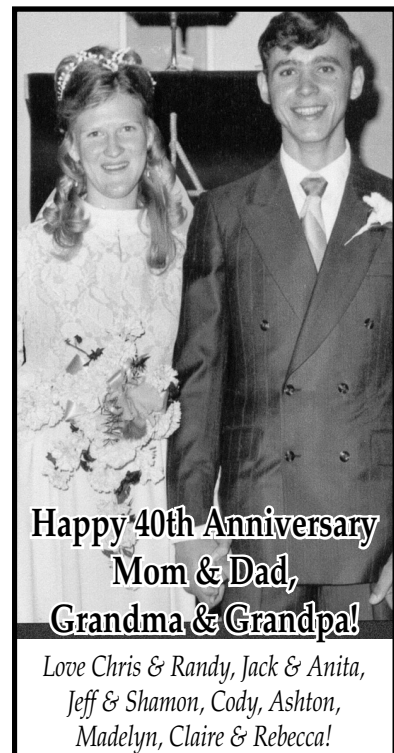
Happy New Year Ladies!
