lies, a breakfast for Doctors' Appreciation Week, and a meeting of the Halton Ministerial Group.

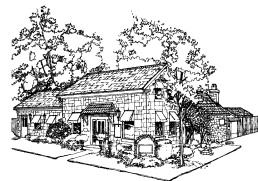
Always community-minded, Mountainview Residence has also sponsored the Glen Williams baseball organization, Light up the Hills and the Seniors' Rotary Dinner.
