

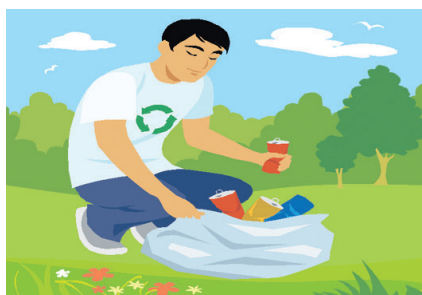
HALTON HILLS COMMUNITY CLEAN-UP

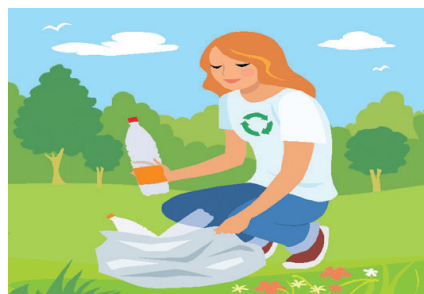
7th Annual Halton Hills 22 MINUTE MAKEOVER Wednesday April 20th, 2011
