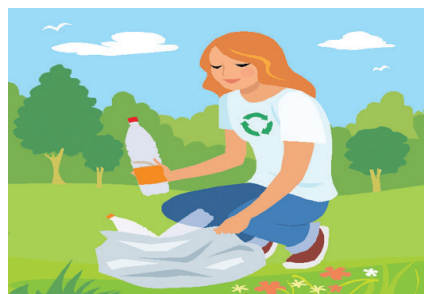
**7th Annual Halton Hills 22 MINUTE MAKEOVER**
