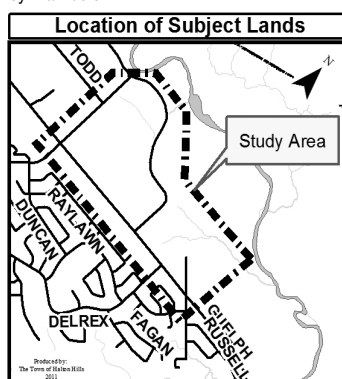

GUELPH STREET - ARMSTRONG AVENUE STORMWATER MANAGEMENT PLAN CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT

The Town of Halton Hills, through their consultant Clipsham Limited, has undertaken a Class Environmental Assessment to review the operating conditions of the existing drainage system and to evaluate alternatives to provide improved stormwater management and erosion control facilities in the industrial and commercial area located north of Guelph Street and east of Sinclair Avenue. The Study Area is shown on the Key Plan below.



The study, which has been planned under Schedule 'C' of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment, has now been completed and an Environmental Study Report (ESR) has been prepared. This ESR confirms the need for the development of new stormwater management works to service the Study Area and identifies the preferred design alternative which includes the construction of a new stormwater management facility east of McFarlane Drive and restoration of existing erosion sites along the watercourse.

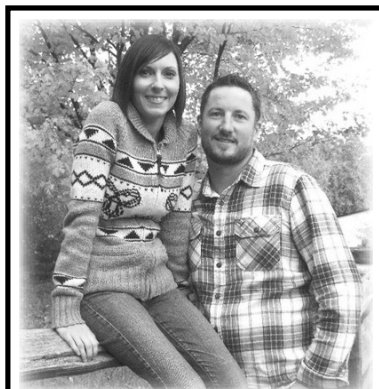

With the exception of personal information, all comments will become part of the public record.
