The Georgetown Bread Basket (Food Bank)

The Georgetown Bread Basket first opened its doors to the hungry in 1996. In 1997 they became an accredited member of the Ontario Association of Food Banks and a registered not-for-profit food bank.

The GGB is entirely run by volunteers. A group of up to 12 directors meet at least monthly to plan the daily activities, and other volunteers from the area generously give their time to help collect and sort food and to assist the clients in their shopping. We are able to serve the clients due to the generous donations of both food and cash that we receive from you, the community.

Until four years ago the food was all non-

perishable. Then came the Fresh Food Box of fresh fruits and vegetables. Thank to donations from the Rotarians and Kiwanis Club, the GGB is able to offer these boxes to our clients on a monthly basis. This helps to achieve the vision "to promote access to healthier eating for clients."

In association with ReFresh Foods, a new regional food collection and distribution initiative, we will have access to surplus perishable goods, including healthier fresh and frozen food, from corporate suppliers. ReFresh Foods enhances the type and quantity of food donations distributed in Halton by using a

refrigerated hybrid truck for distribution of food donations. This does not change the Georgetown Bread Basket's method of collection or distribution of food, but enhances the selection of food for our clients.

We will continue to work in partnership with the great community of Halton Hills to meet the needs of many adults and children in Halton who do not have adequate access to nutritional food - those who live below the poverty line. Yes, even in Halton Hills, hunger and poverty do exist and we must strive to meet the needs of those who cannot afford what we often take for granted.
