Begins the week of July 4 and runs weekly through to the end of the week of August 22. You may attend all 8 weeks or pick weeks that fit your summer schedule.

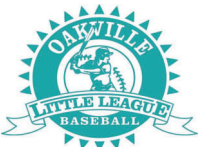
Features of the fun, recreational and educational session include:
