Phil Miller (right) of Miller's Scottish Bakery on Guelph St. handed over a petition to Wellington-Halton Hills MPP Ted Arnott last week, signed by 1,340 people opposed to the Ontario Ministry of Agriculture and Food regulation that classifies the bakery as a free standing meat plant because they sold some of their popular meat pies wholesale. The Millers had to stop selling the pies wholesale or do costly renovations, which they could not afford. Most recently they were told, due to the regulation, they couldn't supply their meat pies to the upcoming Georgetown Highland Games, something they had been doing for 20 years.

## Couple charged with drug offences while daughter, 5, rode in car

A Georgetown couple is facing drug charges after OPP stopped a vehicle in Otonabee-South Monaghan Township (near Peterborough) Thursday morning.

Peterborough County OPP stopped the vehicle about 2:20 a.m. and found 54 marijuana plants, fertilizer and growing equipment in the car. A further 11 grams of marijuana in a plastic baggie and a small quantity of oxycodone was also found on one of the suspects.

Charged with possession of oxycodone, possession of marijuana, production of marijuana and possession of marijuana for the purposes of trafficking is Theodore R. Luscombe, 54, the driver of the car.

Charged with possession of marijuana for the purposes of trafficking, and production of marijuana is Brenda Luscombe, 48, the passenger. They are to appear in court in Peterborough June 23.

Police say the couple was accompanied by their five-year-old daughter.
