

Local schools to get full-day Kindergarten

Halton District School Board has the required approval from the Ministry of Education to proceed with program implementation for the 2013-2014 (Year 4) and 2014-2015 (Year 5) full day Kindergarten (FDK) program.

Six Halton Hills public schools are on the list.

In selecting these school sites for Year 4 and 5, the Ministry of Education required the Halton District School Board to work collaboratively with the Halton Catholic District School Board and the Region of Halton, and consider the following criteria: available space within the school, availability

of purpose built Kindergarten rooms, community factors including demographics and local needs, impact on co-terminus Board and regional child care, and identified needs in the Board Improvement Plan.
