

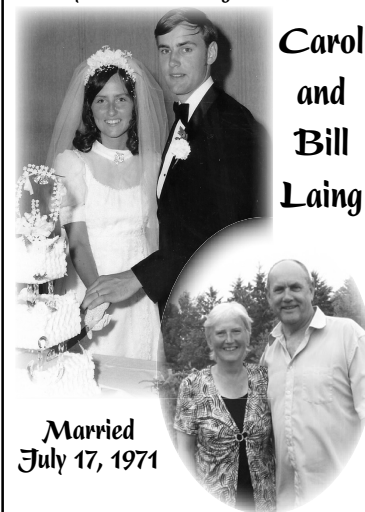


## Two-car crash

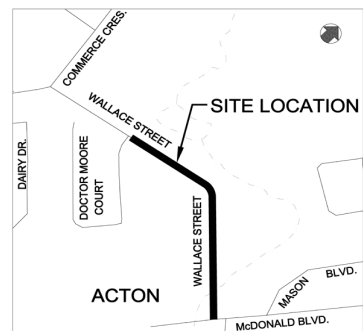
