

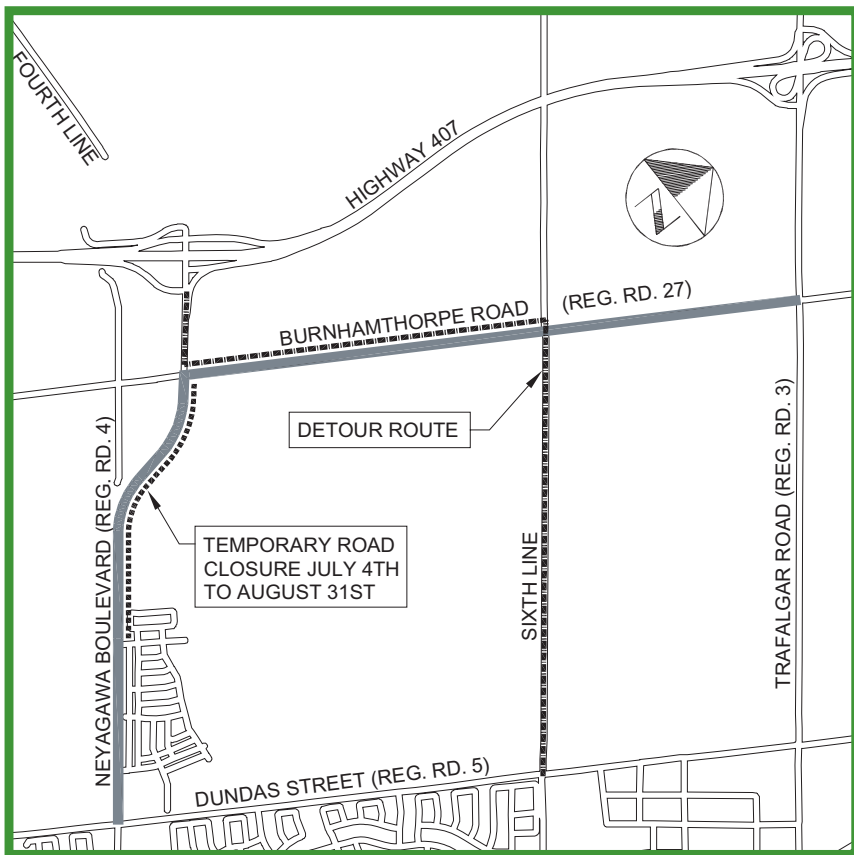
**ROAD CLOSURE ALERT**

For general waste and use of the Container Station, the user fees are:

- Up to 50 kg – \$5/load
- 51 to 150 kg – \$10/load
- Over 150 kg – 14.3 cents/kg starting from 0 kg

**Did You Know?**

The following materials are accepted free of charge at the Halton Waste Management Site:

- Plastic plant pots and trays – up to a pick-up truck load
- Electronics (computers, printers, and televisions, etc.) – up to 5 items per load
- Household hazardous waste (paint, batteries, antifreeze, propane tanks, car oil) – up to 20 L per trip, residential loads only
- Used tires – up to 5 tires per load
