

# Youth nabbed in police investigation

A 15-year-old Georgetown boy is facing four counts of possession of stolen property after police were called to the John St. area about 1:20 a.m. Tuesday. A 15-year-old Georgetown girl was diverted to the Halton Youth Justice program.

An area resident had contacted police after seeing people inside a car parked in a driveway on that street. Police responded and apprehended three youths a short time later. Property was recovered that was believed stolen from vehicles in the McNabb and John St. area including an iPod docking station, GPS and books. 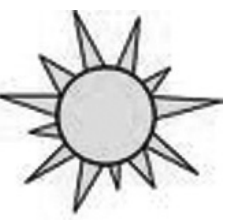
