How to Help Green Your Office While Saving Money

The laser printer has become an essential part of today's computer driven office environment. It is possible to get perfect prints, save money, and reduce your environmental impact at the same time.

The average laser toner cartridge weighs about 2 kg and is about 40% plastic, 40% metal, and 20% rubber, foam, and toner. The plastic will last for hundreds of years in a landfill. Each year, more than 300 million cartridges end up in landfills.

Remanufacturing is the process of refurbishing a used cartridge so it can be used again. Cartridges are collected, disassembled, cleaned, and necessary components replaced. High quality toner, specifically formulated and measured for each printer, is added and the cartridges are individually quality tested.

About 3 litres of oil are burned producing each new cartridge. A cartridge can be reused multiple times, saving the 3 litres of fuel each time. Every cartridge that is remanufactured is one fewer going into a landfill.

Our carbon footprint is a measurement of the impact our activities have on the environment. It relates to the amount of greenhouse gases produced in our day-to-day lives through the burning of fossil fuels. When you buy food and goods, their production and the distance that they travel to you affects the size of your footprint. Most new cartridges are made overseas (look on your box). Using locally produced cartridges helps reduce your carbon footprint and strengthens your local economy and creates jobs.

You can help green your office and save money too. Remanufactured cartridges are 30 to 60% less expensive than originals and will not void the warranty on your new printer.

Choosing remanufactured products is one way to reduce the environmental impact of printer cartridges, while getting a high-quality product and saving money.
