to 400 homes, businesses were destroyed by a wildfire in May. Earlier this month, flooding rains swamped the remaining homes.

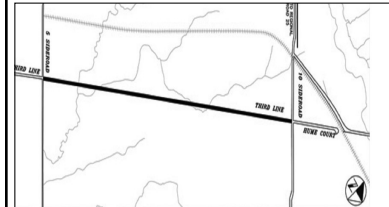
In an initiative started by the Township of North Stormont, all Ontario municipalities are being asked to match the \$100 donation.
