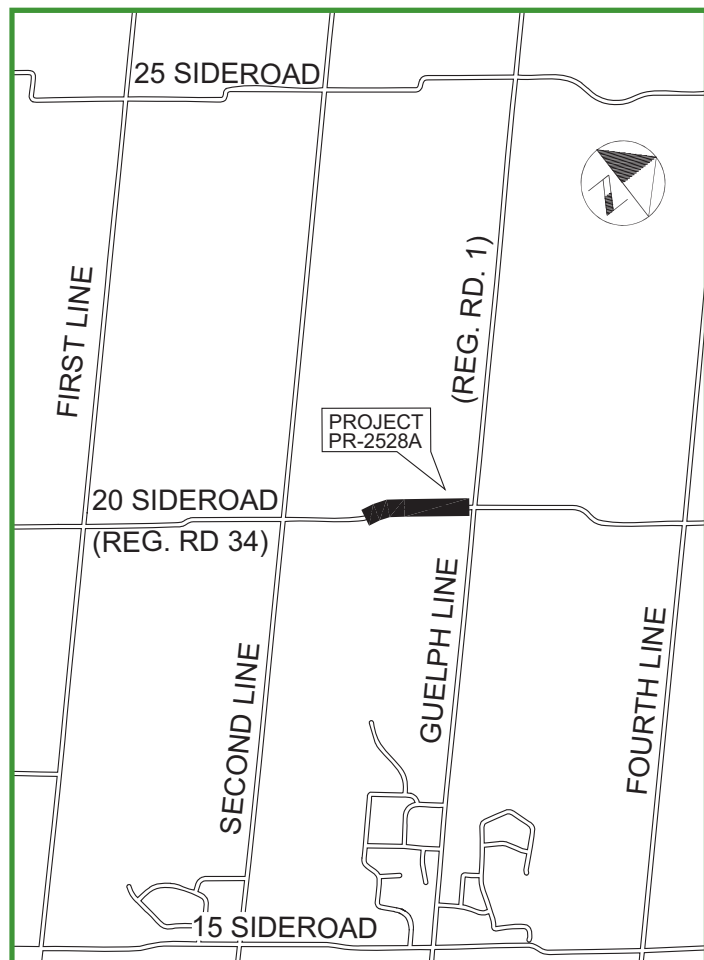

Halton Region launched a pilot project early this summer to allow residents to recycle plastic plant pots and trays. Plastic pots and trays are currently not accepted in the Region's Blue Box program because the plastic is difficult to process with the other acceptable materials, but they can be recycled if they are collected separately.
