Local teen on the mend after horrific crash

A 17-year-old male Georgetown driver was airlifted to Hamilton General Hospital Friday after the VW Jetta he was driving collided with a cement truck Friday afternoon at the intersection of Steeles Avenue and Thompson Road in Milton. According to Halton Police, the westbound Jetta was turning south onto Thompson Road when it collided with the eastbound truck. Steeles Avenue was closed in both directions for more than five hours for the police investigation. The youth was originally reported to have suffered life-threatening injuries however, he is recovering well and is expected to be released from hospital soon. Longtime councillor to run for provincial Liberals

The Wellington-Halton Hills Provincial Liberal Association is set to nominate longtime Halton Hills Councillor Moya Johnson as the Liberal candidate for the upcoming provincial election.

The nomination meeting will take place on Thursday, August 11 at 7:30 p.m. at the

Rockwood Library, 85 Christie St., Rockwood.

"Moya has a strong and proven record of community service and is a powerful advocate for Wellington-Halton Hills," said Murray Gold, President of the Wellington-Halton Hills PLA. "We're very pleased to have such a strong candidate."

Johnson said she did a lot of thinking about whether she would accept the can-

didacy when approached but decided, "I would do it for my community. I believe, just as when I ran for council, complaining doesn't do any good, you must act."

Incumbent Wellington-Halton Hills Ted Arnott was acclaimed as the Progressive Conservative candidate last November while the New Democratic Party nominated
