Minister won't commit to hospital funding

Minister of Health and Long-Term Care Deb Matthews didn't commit to providing any funding to the Georgetown Hospital renovation in either a letter sent to Mayor Rick Bonnette last week or a face-to-face meeting yester-

day (Monday).

In Monday's meeting she told Bonnette "we are looking at your proposal very carefully as well as many other hospital projects."

"What I can tell you is your proposal is still alive," she said.

In the letter received by Bonnette Wednesday afternoon to a letter he had

sent to Matthews earlier requesting the Province kick in nearly \$1.9 million to the hospital project, she said, "the Ministry is currently reviewing the proposal and I'm confident it will be given due consideration."

Halton Healthcare Services wants to spend \$12.19 million to renovate
