## Candidate snapshots

### Ted Arnott Progressive Conservatives

As the election campaign began, Arnott reflected on four years serving Wellington-Halton Hills and 21 years in the Ontario Legislature.

"I want to thank my outstanding staff, our supporters, and everyone we've worked with along the way," said Arnott.

September 6 was the 21st anniversary of Arnott's first election to the Ontario Legislature in 1990. He won the newly-created riding of Wellington-Halton Hills in 2007 with 49 per cent of the vote.

"It's been an enormous privilege to serve," said Arnott. "But now we look forward to the promise of the future. I hope my greatest contribution to the people of our area is yet to come."

He pointed to some of the most significant accomplishments in just the past three months on behalf of the people of Wellington-Halton Hills:

- Helping secure \$2.6 million in funding for Georgetown Hospital's ER and CT scanner project
- Obtaining approval for new Groves Memorial Community Hospital in Centre Wellington
- Helping Jasper More's family with approval of coverage for the medication Naglazyme for MPS VI
- Successfully calling for suspension of the GTA West Corridor Study, pending review by the next Minister

of Transportation

- Receiving recognition at Queen's Park for having taken the lead to pass a bill observing Emancipation Day in Ontario—the first bill that was co-sponsored by MPPs of different parties, working together

- Helping PNH patient Lucas Macieszka and his family, who required a life-saving medication called Soliris; also successfully calling for the government to cover the cost of Soliris for patients who needed it

- Receiving Honorary Membership in the Ontario Association of Road Supervisors for working on their behalf; this adds to Arnott's Honorary Membership in the Fire Fighters' Association of Ontario, for his work to protect volunteer fire-

fighters

"We've had a very productive summer. Working together, we accomplished a great deal," he said. "I look forward to continuing my work on behalf of the people of Wellington-Halton Hills."

Arnott lives in Fergus with his wife, Lisa, who teaches Core French at James McQueen Public School. They have three sons.
