CDH to receive \$240,000 in funding

Regional council has approved funding for Community Development Halton (CDH).

The agency will receive \$240,000 in funding from Halton Region for 2012.

The majority of the funds, \$175,000, will be used to support Volunteer Halton and the remaining \$65,000 will go toward social planning.

Staff had recommended a significant decrease to the agency's funding for next year to \$100,000 and eliminating funding all together in 2013. However, following an outcry from several of Halton's community advocates, regional staff recommended continued funding for the agency for one-year terms, depending on performance checks and budget approval.


