Madole opens Water-mark on Saturday

The Canadian landscape is shaped by the power of water— by rivers, and lakes, and glaciers—and one of Canada's leading watercolour painters, Marlene Madole, shares her personal vision of that landscape through her new exhibition of watercolour paintings, titled *Water-mark*, at the Williams Mill Gallery,

The opening reception will be held on Saturday, Oct. 15, 7-10 p.m. In addition to the evening reception, Marlene will also be present in the Williams Mill Gallery on the Sunday, Oct. 16, 1-4 p.m.

For 17 years, Madole has operated her painting studio at the Williams Mill Visual Arts Centre in Glen Williams, where she is one of the founding artists— at the same time, she also traveled across Canada, from coast to coast, gathering inspiration and reference material for her paintings.

"I've always treated my travels as a kind of research," says Madole, "though it's clearly more than that. I encounter the landscape, the shorelines, the light,

and the spaces— all of it changes you, and it changes how you feel about it afterward, and what you choose to present at a moment in time. All this, and it provides a never-ending source of inspiration for the future."

Drawn from those travels, and painted both both en plein air and in the studio, Marlene's paintings in this show range from Prince Edward Island to the Pacific Rim, from the French River to Georgian Bay and Lake Huron, from Alberta's Kananaskis district, to the BC interior, including the Okanagan and Atlin Lake, and ranging far north

An award-winning artist and teacher, Madole is an elected member and a Past President of the Canadian Society of Painters in Water Colour (CSPWC).

The Williams Mill Gallery is located in the Williams Mill Visual Arts Centre, at 515 Main St., Glen Williams. Gallery hours, in addition to the reception, are Wednesday to Sunday, 12-5 p.m.
