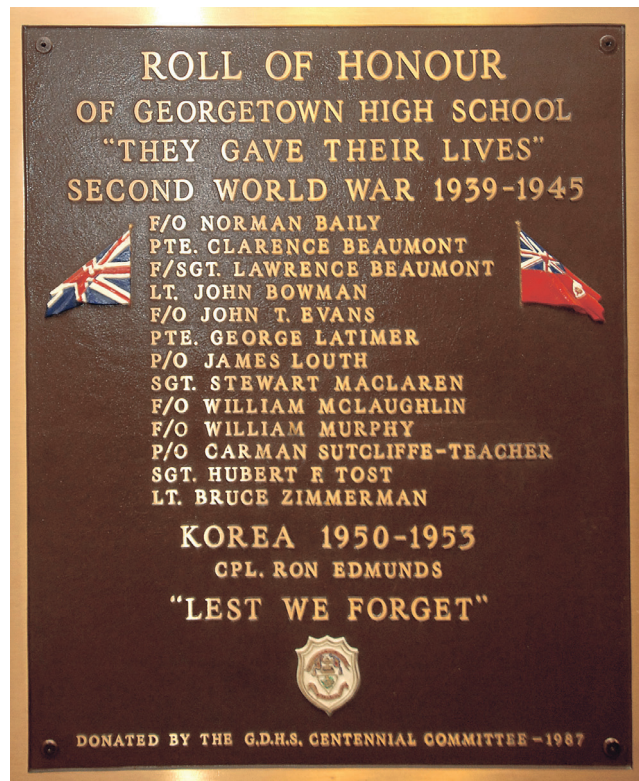
connected today's GDHS students with the past. We have lots of history, and this helps remind us all."
