

Driver had medical condition

The death of a 63-year-old Georgetown man Monday is not related to the single-vehicle collision the man was involved in on Ninth Line, but to a pre-existing medical condition, said Sgt. Paul Davies of the Halton Regional Police Collision Reconstruction Unit.

The collision occurred about 2 p.m. near 10 Sideroad. Davies said the man, whose name was not released by police, suffered a medical condition, most likely cardiac arrest.

He said the car left the road, went into a ditch, came back up and struck a tree.

Skateboarder hit by vehicle

A 15-year-old boy escaped serious injury after he was struck by a vehicle while skateboarding at Guelph St. and Maple Ave. at 3:25 p.m. Monday. No charges were laid.

General Committee for the Town of Halton Hills will conduct a Public Meeting to examine and discuss a proposed application for a Proposed Plan of Subdivision, an amendment to the Town of Halton Hills Zoning By-law 2010-0055, as amended and a Common Element Condominium. The proposed application applies to the lands legally described as Lot 11, Concession 9. The subject site is located at the northwest corner of Mountainview Road and Danby Road in South Georgetown.

Below is a map showing the location of the subject property to which the proposed application would apply.

The purpose and effect of the proposed applications is to permit a Draft Plan of Subdivision Application (File D12SUB11.001) consisting of seven (7) blocks of Medium Density Residential (37 units through Part Lot Control - File D25PLC11.002); one (1) Private Road Block (Common Element Condominium - File D07CDM11.001), one (1) Walkway Block and one (1) Commercial Block and the applicable Zoning Amendments (File D14ZBA11.006) to permit the proposed uses. The site is also subject to two (2) Site Plan Approval Applications one for the Commercial (D11SPA11.010) and one for the Residential (D11SAP11.011).

If you wish to be notified of the decision of the Town of Halton Hills in respect of this proposed, Zoning By-law Amendment and Plan of Subdivision, you must make a written request to the Town of Halton Hills at 1 Halton Hills Drive, Halton Hills, Ontario L7G 5G2.

NOTES:

- 1. If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Halton Hills before the by-law is passed, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Town of Halton Hills to the Ontario Municipal Board (OMB).

2. If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Halton Hills before the by-law is passed, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the OMB unless, in the opinion of the OMB, there are reasonable grounds to do so.

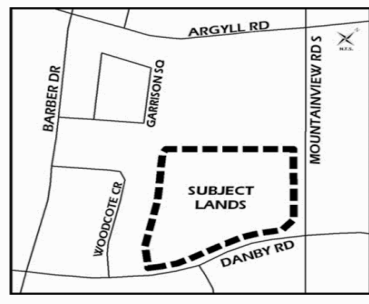
3. If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or written submissions to the Town of Halton Hills in respect of the proposed plan of subdivision before the approval authority gives or refuses to give approval to the draft plan of subdivision, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Town of Halton Hills to the OMB.

4. If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or written submissions to the Town of Halton Hills in respect of the proposed plan of subdivision before the approval authority gives or refuses to give approval to the draft plan of subdivision, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the OMB unless, in the opinion of the OMB, there are reasonable grounds to do so.

5. Any written comment/objection submitted to the Town of Halton Hills regarding this application(s) which is being processed under the Planning Act 1990, may be made public as part of the application process.

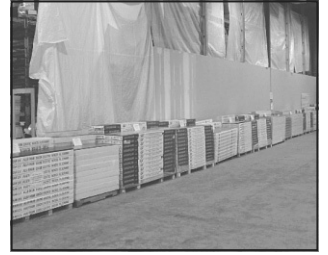
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
