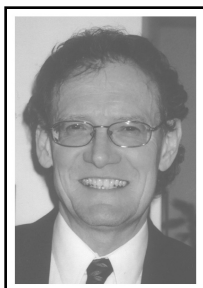
ARMSTRONG, Ellis - In loving memory of a dear husband, father and Grandfather who passed away December 23rd, 2007.
