Halton Police were in the parking lot at Nashville North about 2:45 a.m. Friday conducting an investigation when a man grabbed an officer around the neck and pulled him away. The officer wasn't injured.

Charged with assault a police officer is Corey Alexander Ross, 19, of Mississauga.

Halton Police report someone threw black paint on the front porch of a Regional Rd. 25 home sometime early Monday.

Fire crews raced to the scene of a vehicle fire in the area of Fourth Line and 15 Side Road about 6:30 p.m. Friday.

Crews arrived to find the vehicle fully engulfed in flames. The lone occupant of the car sat in a passerby's vehicle while crews extinguished the fire.

Due to the vehicle striking and damaging a hydro pole, Halton Hills Hydro was called out to the scene.

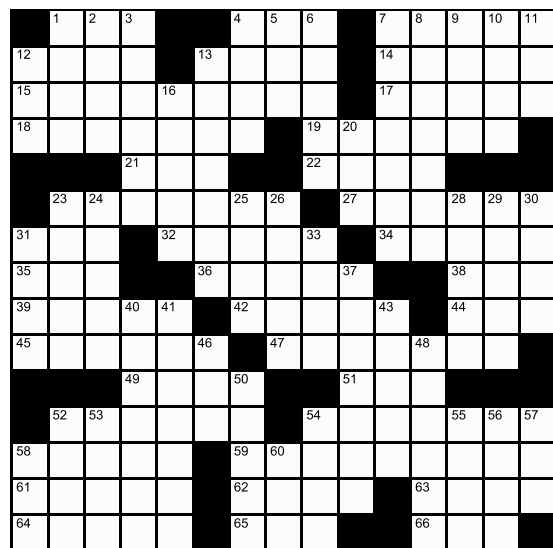
