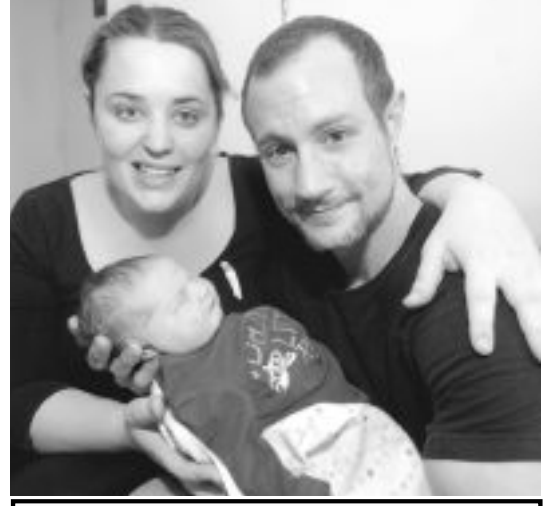


Emily makes great leap forward
